STUDENT WHO FREQUENTLY REPORTS LATE TO SCHOOL WILL LOSE THE PRIVILEGE OF PARKING ON SCHOOL GROUNDS AND FACES FURTHER DISCIPLINARY ACTION WHICH MAY INCLUDE SUSPENSION. ANY VIOLATION OF PARKING REGULATIONS MAY RESULT IN ONE OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING: SUSPENSION OF DRIVING PRIVILEGES FOR PART OR ALL OF THE SCHOOL YEAR, SUSPENSION FROM SCHOOL, TOWING OF

 PARKING ON SCHOOL GROUNDS WHILE PERMIT IS REVOKED WILL RESULT IN 30 ADDITIONAL DAYS AND/OR SUSPENSION.
