This form begins the process to determine if the student is college ready. All students must demonstrate college readiness in order to take Dual Enrollment classes by placement scores for English & Mathematics. **Certain classes like English, math and science require prerequisites or specific placement testing.**

- The first time a student takes a dual enrollment (DE) course they will be **required to apply online with NOVA** at <https://apply.vccs.edu/>. Within 24 hours of applying to NOVA, the student must login to myNOVA and set up security questions.
- Under section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), **disability services are available to you if you are currently enrolled**, have a documented disability that substantially limits you in one or more of life's major activities, and are otherwise academically qualified. To use services in a NOVA class, **you must apply online** at NOVA's Disability Services website. (<https://www.nvcc.edu/disability-services/>)
- DE courses are part of a NOVA transcript which must be sent to any college/university the student attends. There may be times when college grading policies differ from those of the high school. Please always check your myNOVA account to verify your course enrollment and college grade.
- The student's lack of participation/attendance may negatively affect his/her ability to stay in a dual enrollment course. Should the student not pass the first semester of a 2-semester (full-year) course with a D or better, he/she will be automatically dropped from the second semester DE class.
- In accordance with the contract between NOVA and the school district, DE courses that take place in the high school are free of charge. The signatures of the parent/guardian and student allow the district and NOVA to share necessary academic information with each other. The signature of the student allows the high school to share dual enrollment academic information with his/her parent/guardian.
- DE students are expected to engage in college level course contents and discussions appropriate for adult learners. Mature topics may be discussed.
